SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE 1.0

The 'safeguarding children and young people policy' provides guidance and information on how schools, preschools and early childhood services can fulfil their legal obligations and individual responsibilities to keep children and young people safe.

The updated policy and new procedure apply to internal and external stakeholders, including staff, corporate office, volunteers, students, families and external service providers.

This policy describes the scope of obligations that must be met to maintain child safe environments in department schools, early childhood education and care services, including through the provision of child protection curriculum. This policy describes the roles and responsibilities of education and care staff and volunteers in establishing and maintaining child safe environments, including through the provision of child protection curriculum.
